# Final Reminder! Professional Development Reimbursement Entitlements

Professional Development Reimbursement Entitlements Ensure you utilise your reimbursement entitlements before you finish at Mater!

Medical officers (JHOs and SHOs) can apply for professional support up to the value of \$1500.00 per annum (pro rata for part time Medical Officers and those Medical Officers who are employed for less than 12 months on fixed term arrangements) to support the costs of attending relevant courses, conferences and educational events as well as professional fees and materials as per your enterprise agreement.

To apply, please submit the PDS reimbursement application form along with evidence of your education expenses to your Manager/Director. If you are a rotational resident please submit your form and evidence to <u>mededu@mater.org.au</u> to seek approval. Requests must be

submitted by 13 December 2023 to be processed prior to the end of the clinical year.
